

Postdoctoral fellowships and doctoral students in the field of Academic communication, and English language and linguistics at the Technion – Israel Institute of Technology

Start: October 2024 (flexible)

As part of a new research initiative, applications are invited for full-time doctoral students and postdoctoral positions at the Department of Humanities & Arts of the Technion in Haifa, Israel. The successful candidate will become part of the new language and communication workgroup supervised by Dr. Tzipora Rakedzon and conduct independent and collaborative research.

The goal of the new workgroup is to conduct cutting-edge research in the field of academic writing, or in the broader field of academic communication, and to foster interdisciplinary collaborations that link the humanities to science and technology. This may include especially the development of, and research using, NLP-based tools. While we have some preference for scholars working on such topics, the research topic is open and other suggestions related to English/linguistics/NLP are welcome.

The applicant is required to have an MA/MSc with a thesis to apply for a doctorate, or a Ph.D. awarded or close to completion for the postdoctoral fellowship. The degree should be in either linguistics or computer-related fields such as AI/NLP. The ability and desire to conduct independent research are essential; a publication record in a pertinent field is highly desirable.

For doctoral students, scholarships are available; for postdoctoral fellows, there is a generous monthly fellowship, and the duration is 1 year (with the option for extension).

For US PhDs applying for a post-doc, the [Fulbright](#) offers a potentially generous program for those who are eligible and accepted.

The application (in English) should include:

- CV, including a list of publications
- A writing sample
- A research proposal (2-3 pages)
- Two letters of recommendation
